#### AVAILABILITY:

In all communities served for single-phase residential electric service. The customer's wiring must be arranged so that all service can be measured through one meter.

#### RATE:

Base Rate:	\$10.00 per month
On-Peak Energy:	For all Kwh's used during peak hours designated as 12 p.m. to 8 p.m. local time, Monday through Friday.
	October-May            6.495¢ per Kwh
	June-September      9.495¢ per Kwh
Off-Peak Energy:	6.495¢ per Kwh for all energy not covered by the On-Peak rating period.

#### MINIMUM BILL:

Base Rate.

#### PAYMENT:

Bills will be considered past due if not paid by the due date shown on the bill. Past due bills are subject to a late payment charge in accordance with the provisions of Rate 109 or any amendments or alterations thereto.

#### ELECTRIC UNIVERSAL SYSTEM BENEFITS CHARGE:

Bills are subject to an Electric Universal System Benefits Charge for purposes of funding Universal System Benefit Programs as provided in Rate 55, or any amendments or alterations thereto.

#### FUEL AND PURCHASED POWER COST TRACKING ADJUSTMENT:

Bills are subject to an adjustment for cost of fuel and purchased power as provided in Rate 58, or any amendments or alterations thereto.

#### GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. Customer agrees to contract for service under the Optional Time-of-Day Residential Electric Service rate for a minimum period of one year. At the end of a one-year period, customer shall have the option of remaining under the Optional Time-of-Day Residential Electric Service rate or of returning to the regular Residential Electric Service rate.
2. Low-Income Discount: Customers qualifying for and receiving energy assistance through the Low Income Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP) administered by the State of Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services (DPHHS) shall obtain a discount from the amount billed under this rate schedule. The applicable discount, as set forth below, will be administered based upon information supplied to the Company by DPHHS at the time the customer qualifies for LIEAP.

<u>% Of Federal Poverty</u>	<u>Discount Rate</u>
0-60%	30%
61%-90%	25%
91%-150%	20%

3. The foregoing schedule is subject to Rates 101-131 and any amendments or alterations thereto or additional rules and regulations promulgated by the Company under the laws of the state.
